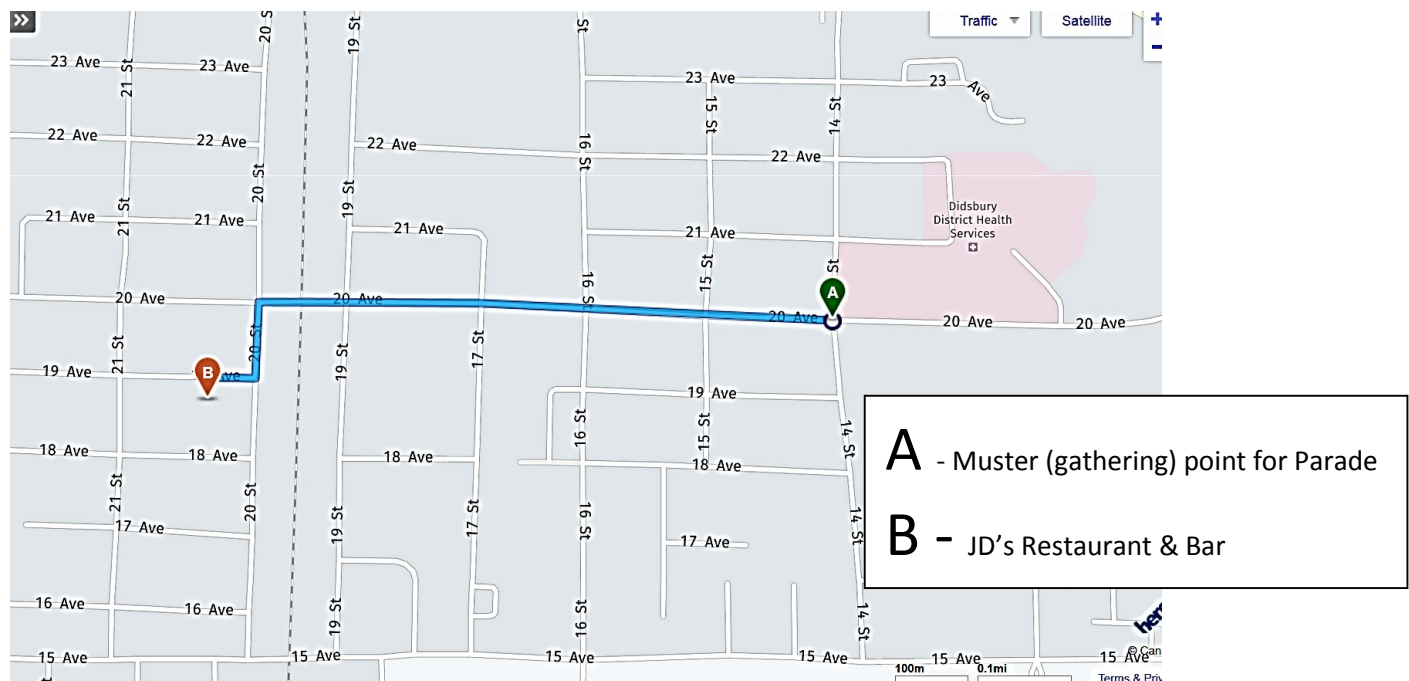

Suggested Guidelines

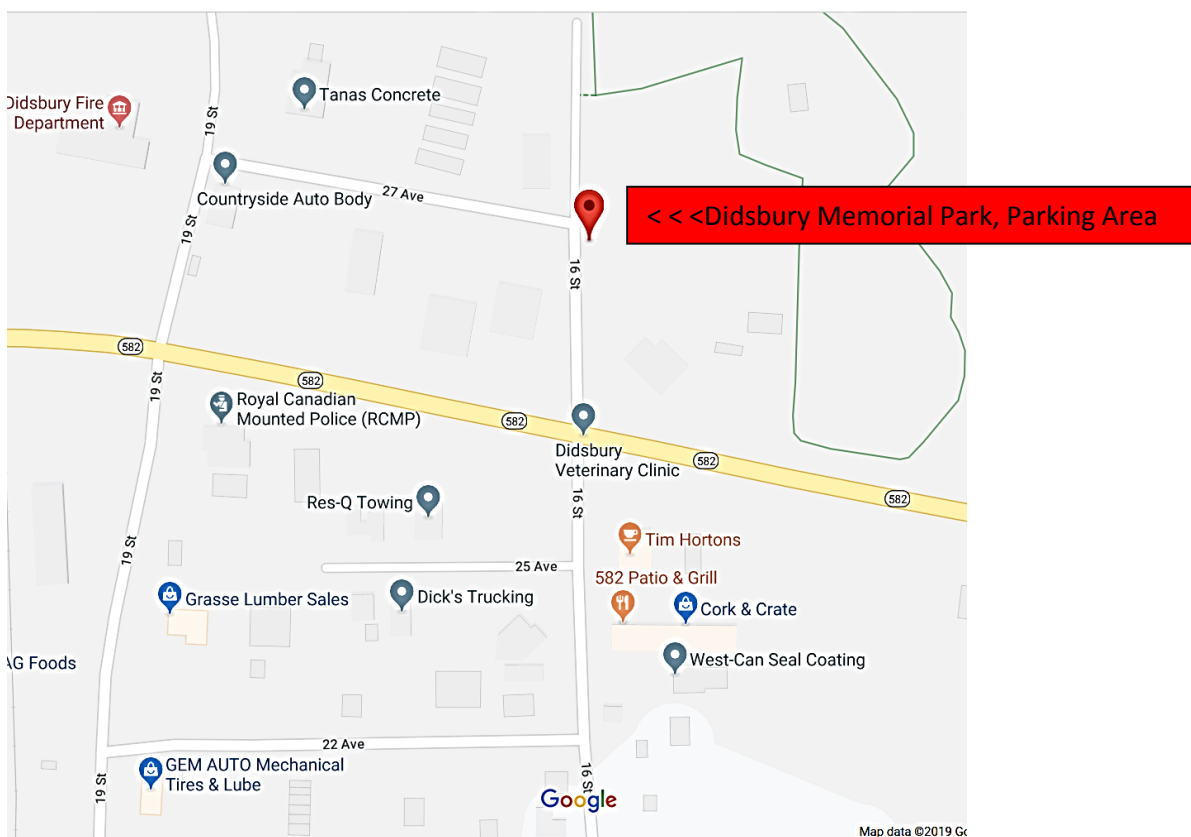
- Corgis only with our group, no other breeds.
- Puppies are welcome. Owners to decide upon puppies abilities in a “parade” environment.
- One handler may walk one or two Corgis only, no more.
- All dogs must be on a leash no longer than 6 feet.

- Each handler to carry water and poop bags for their one or two Corgis.
- For every 6 dogs entered we should have one volunteer person who can walk in the parade as our chaperones (to act as a safeguard during the walk, and to assist handlers where/when needed, and to relieve the banner walker if required). Visitors and guests are welcome to join in the walk.
- Handlers to wear their best Corgi outfits, tee-shirts, hats, badges, whatever.
- Corgis may wear bandanas, but no extreme costumes, please.
- We need a volunteer person who can walk up front with our banner.

Memorial Park Picnic Gathering And Backup Plan

We will meet at the parking lot of the Memorial Park on the north side of Didsbury.



Be prepared to walk to the “actual” park from the parking area.

- Bring whatever supplies are needed for the well-being of you and your Corgi in this group environment and for the weather.

- Bring your own picnic lunch – Tim Horton’s is located very close by, should you wish to purchase lunch.
